<b>CORE COURSE REQUIREMENTS</b>	
<b>Completion of a Spanish (B.A.) requires THIRTY (30) HOURS in SPA course numbered 200 or above. A minimum of 21 hours must be at a level of 300 or above.</b>	
♣ Students entering SPA 102 by referral or placement will receive three (3) hours credit for SPA 101 if they make an "A" in 102.	
☞ Students entering SPA 201 by referral or placement receive six (6) hours credit for SPA 101 and 102 if they make an "A" or "B" in 201.	
‡ Spanish majors are required to take SPA 321S in order to fulfill ACCT. This will also fulfill 3 hours of the 300 level or above requirement.	
<b>ASO 100</b>	<b>Student Success Seminar</b>

☞ A grade of "C" or higher is required in each course for credit toward the major. Students are required to maintain a 2.75 GPA in their major.

☞ Exit Requirement: a passing score on a departmental Spanish proficiency exam which covers spoken and written language, culture and literature.

You are advised to meet with the Chair of the Department of Foreign Languages & Humanities or with an academic advisor prior to registration for appropriate placement in SPA courses.

**Upper division courses** (All students are required to have a minimum of 42 hrs. upper division courses distributed throughout Major/Supporting/Gen Ed/Free Electives categories).

All baccalaureate degree seeking students who enter the University are required to successfully complete one writing intensive course following completion of the ENG 102, ENG 105, or HON 102/103. Writing intensive courses are designated with the suffix "W" following the course prefix and number (e.g. HUM 300W).

**Applied Critical & Creative Thinking (ACCT) Requirement:** Spanish majors will fulfill ACCT with SPA 321S or a program approved study abroad experience. (Credit hours are incorporated into program requirements.)
